

1. Start by coloring your whole canvas. In a flat color, or a gradient, what you prefer. For this example, i use a gradient.



2. Then choose your motiv. I will take a fish.



3. Next step is to transfer your motiv, font or what you like to your canvas.



4. Now cover up your whole motiv.




Thats's the relevant step.


For covering, you can choose what you like. In the video, they used toothpaste. Also there is some "masking fluid" on the market.


Here in this image, it is shown with masking tape from the hardware store (painters tape goes perfect) >> cut the edges with a sculpters knife.

At the end, your whole "motiv" or font should be covered.



5. Now hit it hard, paint over the whole canvas. The best would be spray paint, so you did'nt ruin your masking tape or tooth paste.







Wait, until spray paint is completely dried. I would wait a day for presure wash..

Final Step.....

6. Pull the masking tape away. If you used toothpaste, give your canvas a solid pressure wash (or strong shower)



et voilà
